Flu Vaccination

We have been made aware that some parents are concerned that if their child develops a high temperature after having the vaccine, they won't know whether to isolate and book a test or not for Covid-19. [This poster](https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/vaccinations/child-flu-vaccine/) emphasises why it is important to get the flu vaccine and this link <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/vaccinations/child-flu-vaccine/>. The nasal spray flu vaccine can cause a mild fever which should respond to paracetamol. Giving the child a flu vaccine means that the family is less likely to get flu so less likely to need testing and self-isolation. Therefore the key things is that a temperature following the vaccine will respond to paracetamol, whereas Covid won't.

ROAD CLOSURE
