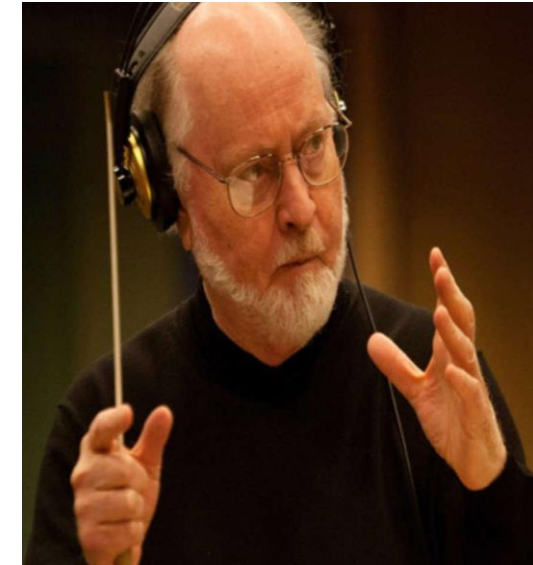


Charles-Camille **Saint Sans** - was a French composer who lived during Victorian times and died in 1921. For fun and to amuse his friends he wrote 14 short pieces each one painting a picture of a different animal. These are great fun to listen to and guess which animal he is trying to show. This term we will study one of these pieces called **Fossils**. When you hear it think about the different instruments Saint Saens uses in the piece and how he makes the audience think about fossils.



John Williams is an American composer of film music. He has composed music for films such as Jaws, ET, Star Wars, Indiana Jones and the Harry Potter series. In 1993 he wrote the sound track to a film all about bringing dinosaurs back to life from fossils, Jurassic Park. He watched how the dinosaurs moved in the film and used that to create rhythms in his music.
