Tuesday 14th January 2020

As part of our Spring Term science topic on evolution, we are planning to take the Year six children to Peterborough museum to explore 'Evidence of Evolution'.

The day will be split into three sections:

- What can fossils tell us about evolution?
- Exploring the theory of human evolution by looking at skulls.
- Looking at different forms of adaptation within species.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink for the day and should wear school uniform and appropriate outdoor attire for walking to the museum.

We are asking for voluntary contributions of £9.20 per child which covers the cost of transport and workshops. In order to keep costs down, we will be using the local bus service as opposed to a private coach. Payment and permission should be made on our Parentpay site **no later than 7th January 2020.**

No other spending money will be necessary. The 1988 Education Act requires school to ask parents to contribute voluntarily to school visits. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please speak to Mrs Smith if you are likely to find this difficult.
