Following on from the letter sent out yesterday regarding the possible reopening of school to more pupils in June we wanted to ask for your thoughts and opinions regarding what this might look like for the children of St. Michael's. **We would like you to provide feedback via a short questionnaire** (see link below) so that we can continue to try to put an adequate plan in place.

We're waiting for further guidance and clarification from the government right now, which will hopefully help us create an action plan for our phased reopening.
