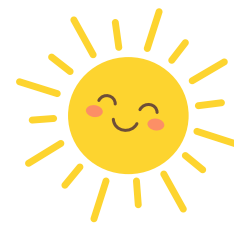

It's a fantastic tool that really helps develop fluency and confidence with number and multiplication facts. If you are having any trouble logging in, please speak to your child's class teacher for support.



Year 1 Phonics Fun

This week, we have been practising all things phonics in every aspect of school life! During our English lessons, we have played lots of fun phonics games to help us recognise our digraphs, trigraphs and especially our tricky split digraphs. We have loved taking part in activities such as real and alien word sorting using popcorn words and ball pit balls, naming our own aliens, and even creating our own names using the colour noodle boxes! We have also been spinning the spinner to read words, going digraph fishing, and sorting chips into the correct sound packets – and much more!

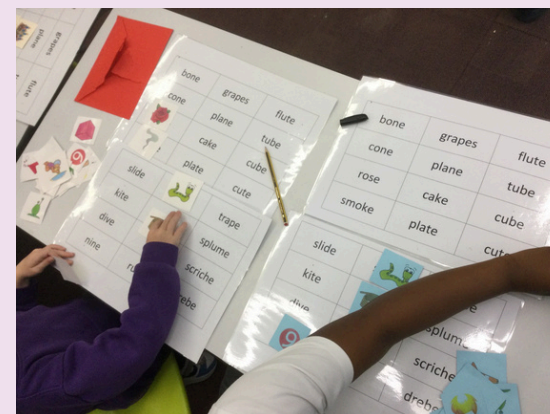
We are so proud of Year 1 and their fantastic effort this week. Keep up the brilliant work as we head towards the phonics screening next week—well done, everyone!



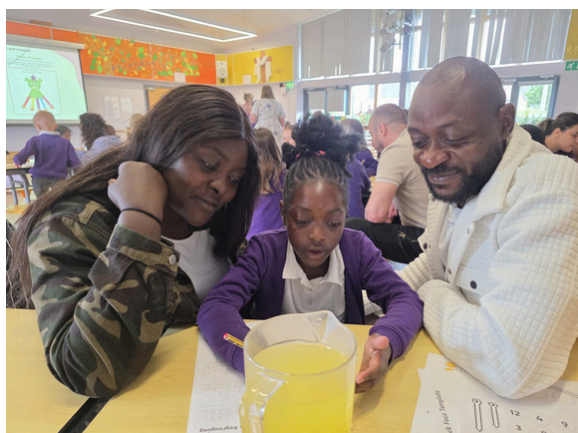
Year 4
