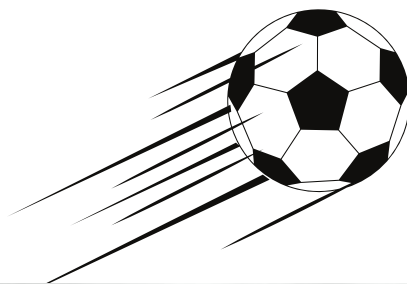

## Polite Parking Reminder

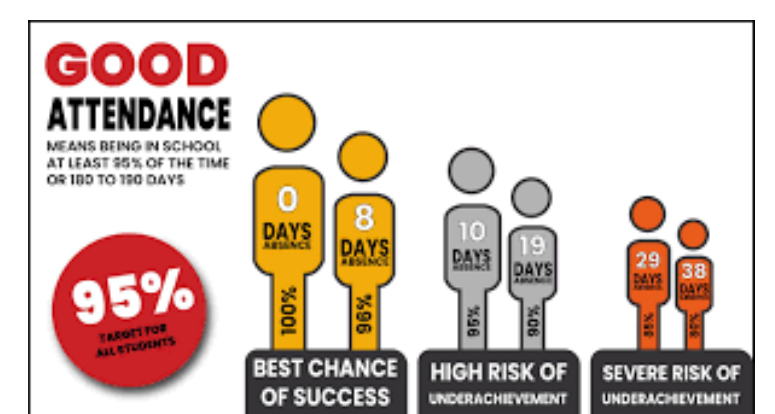
