**Visit Neville Place**

- We will go down to the vaults of the museum and walk inside part of the original Tudor building where we will meet a projected image of the son of Sir Humphrey Orme who built

**Dress like a Tudor**

- Get up close to one of our Tudor portraits, Thomas Cecil and have the chance to dress up in replica Tudor clothing.

**Meet a Tudor Barber Surgeon**

- The Tudor period was a time of very nasty diseases and even nastier cures. Time travel back to 1574 and receive a Tudor ailment! With our Tudor surgeon, find out about the illnesses and how the changes brought about in the Tudor period altered the way patients were treated and how, gradually, old ideas were challenged.



No doubt this will provide a fascinating insight to Tudor life in Peterborough and kick off our learning into the Tudor period.
