

Year 1 Phonics Fest

Year 1 have been super busy having a “Phonics Fest” this week in preparation for our Phonic Screening Checks next week. We have been sorting ‘popcorn’ words into trash and treasure words, making our own alien words up, hunting for alien words on the school field and spotting the different sounds in the words. We’ve even sorted ‘chips’ into sound family chip packets. Our week will finish with a phonics party, complete with phonic part hats, phonics pass the parcel, musical sound statues and writing sounds on biscuits with icing pens.

We’ve also began our Enchanted Tales topic and this started with us exploring ‘Islands’ in Geography. We created our own islands, making sure they had a shoreline, coast and body of water surrounding them. We’ve also began our Sculpture topic in art, practising our skills of rolling, pinching and snipping playdough and clay, along with specifically being able to coil these materials, ready to create our own fairy and elf doors. We can’t wait for you to see these designs!



Year 4s The Romans

We have had a busy start back after half term in Year 4! Our Theme is still The Romans but we will also be learning about Volcanoes too.

In English lessons, we have been writing adventure stories based on Julius Caesar's failed invasion of Britain. The children have had excellent ideas and really given their all to create exciting and interesting pieces of writing.

In Art, the children completed their Roman busts. They worked so hard with clay which can be quite tricky, to create interesting and effective designs.
