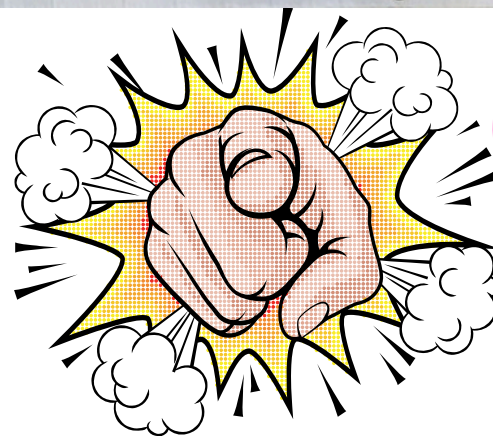


Sports Champs

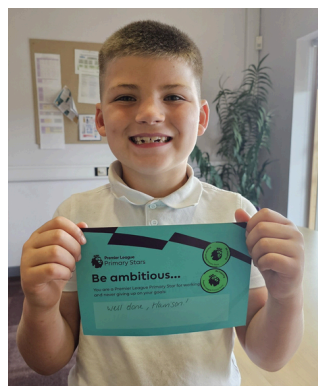

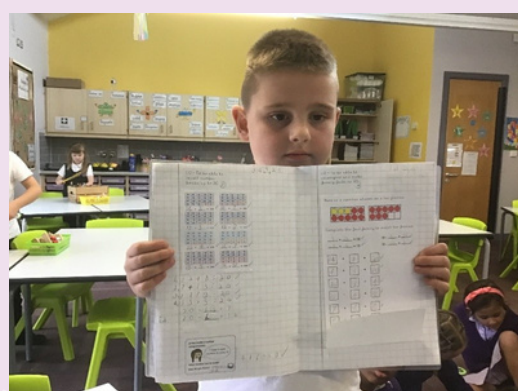

Year 2's Week

In English this week, we have been learning how to write a character description. We have looked at good examples and focused on what the fish, from the story of Tiddler, not only looks like but also their personality. Children have planned their very own character and will write about them tomorrow.

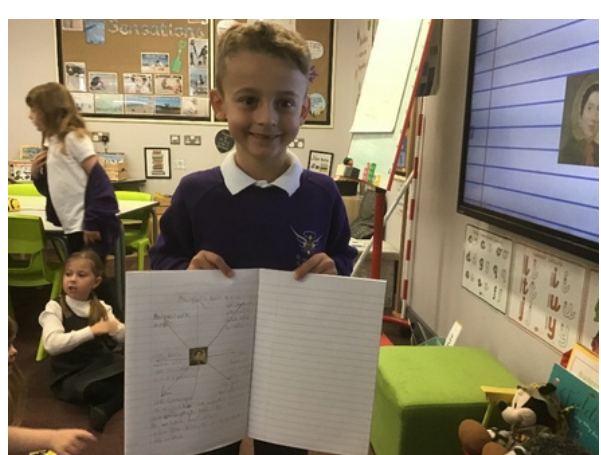
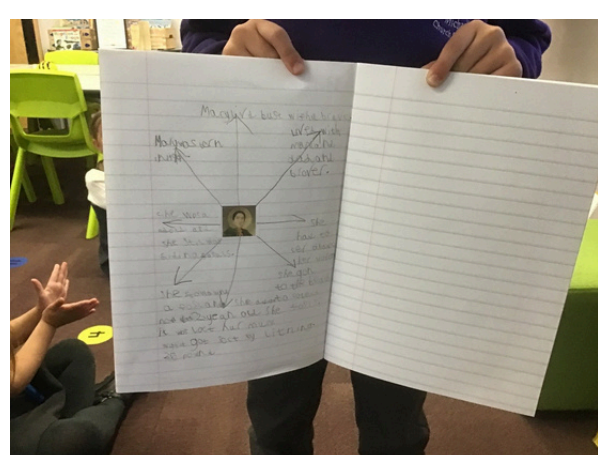
In Maths, we have started our unit on addition and subtraction. This week we have had a recap, prior to our learning of number bonds to 20, and have explored making family facts to 20. The children have found bonds to 20 using counting frames. Today we have used apparatus in pairs to add pairs of 2-digit numbers together.



In computing this half term we have used beebots and this week, children had to predict where the beebots will finish when they input a 4-5 simple instruction. They marked the spot on the table with an 'x' and then inputted the instructions into the beebots observing where it actually finished.



In Theme last week, we learnt about a significant person from the past. We learnt who Mary Anning was and why she was important. We explored facts about both her childhood and adult life. We then produced a spider diagram of key information.



Fun at Ferry Meadows

Year 2 had an exciting adventure to Ferry Meadows to experience science in action! Throughout their day, children took part in a variety of hands-on activities including nature walks, sensory trails, and pond dipping. These immersive experiences allowed them explore the natural world, spark curiosity, and deepen their understanding of the environment—all while having lots of fun outdoors! 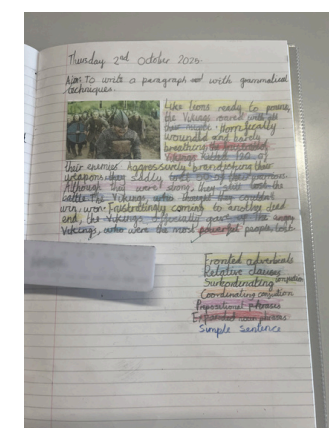
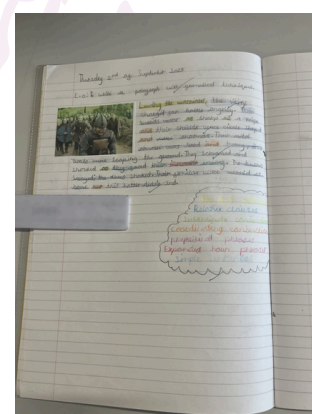
