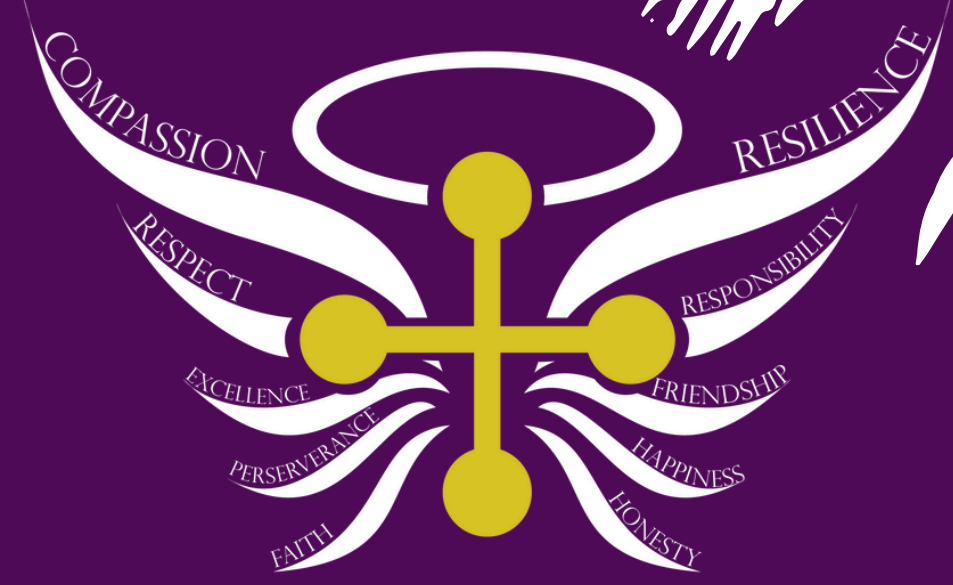

WOW, look at Nathan and Aryia's achievements!



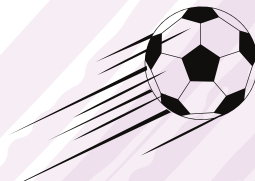

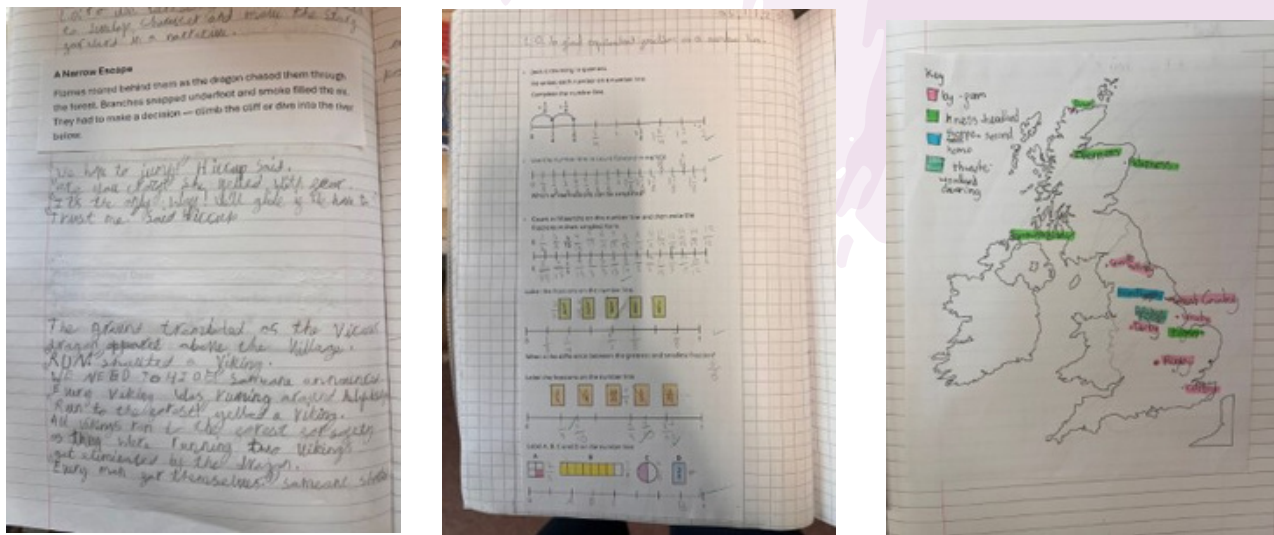
# Footie news....
