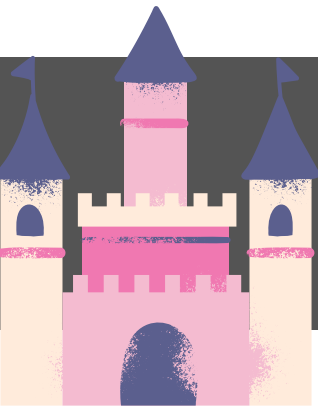

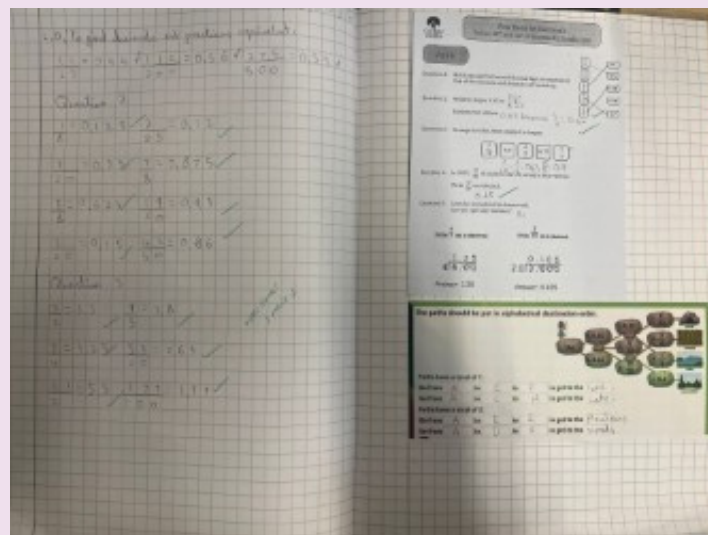
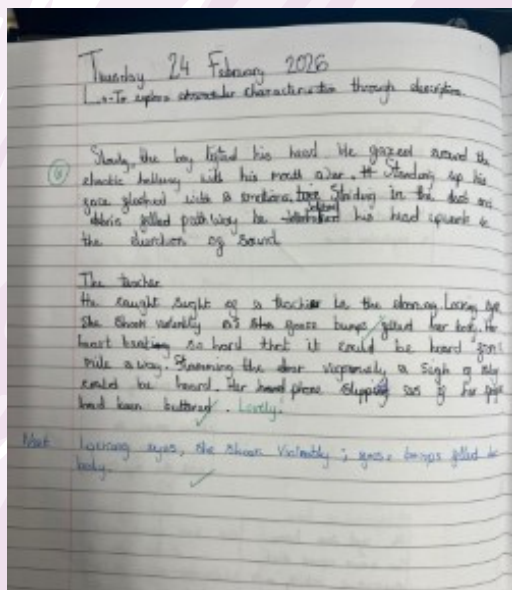
Top 3 classes who have earned the most coins collectively on TTRS.
